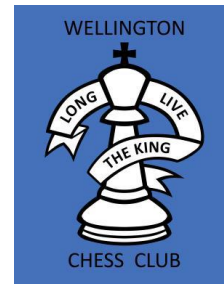

Open to all players of any strength and nationality. One game per day.

Time control 90 minutes for the first 40 moves followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game with the addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Single group 9 round Swiss tournament. Top New Zealand player(s) will be crowned 2017 New Zealand Champion(s), and will have name(s) engraved on Silver Rook. The Major Open title will go to the highest eligible under-2100 (NZCF) rated player.

This event earns NZ Poison Pawn Superclass Grand Prix points for 2016/2017.

Top placed New Zealand player(s) will be the New Zealand Rapid Champion(s) and eligible for the trophy. This event earns Class 2 Poison Pawn Grand Prix points for 2016/2017

Open to all players (any nationality) under 20 years old at 1st January 2017.

Time control: One hour per game, with the addition of 10 seconds per move starting from move one.

This event will be NZCF (New Zealand Chess Federation) rated and will earn Class 2 Poison Pawn Grand Prix points for 2016/2017

Games start 9.30am daily. Finish time is (approximately) 11.45am.

Tournament Regulations

Appeals:

A player may appeal against the decision of an arbiter. An Appeal Committee will be formed, chaired by an arbiter or tournament official not involved in the dispute, with two other members selected from participants in the tournament.

Default Time

The default time for the Open for players arriving late for a game shall be 1 hour and for the Junior Open 30 minutes

Prizes

No player may win more than one cash prize per tournament – the higher prize will apply. Cash prizes will be shared, no tie breaks.
